

**PRODUCT:** Create a slideshow that introduces your biome and the organisms in your food web.

**TIPS:**

- Try to tell a story with your slideshow.
- SHOW NOT TELL...works for slideshows too.
- Use the *power of pictures* to tell the story about your biome.
- Use animation to help tell the story of the food web in your biome.
- Don't kill your audience with too many bullets.

**NECESSARY INFORMATION:** Be sure that your slideshow contains the following information and slides.

1. Where is the biome located in California? Don't forget to show where the "San Francisco Bay Area" and "Union City" are located as well.
2. What is the **climate** like in your biome?
3. What does your biome look like from the distance (a wide shot)?
4. What are some (at least three) types of **producers** that live in your biome?
5. What are some (at least three) types of **consumers** that live in your biome? Make sure you show both **primary consumers** and **secondary consumers**.
6. What are some (at least three) types of **decomposers** that live in your biome?
7. [using animation?] How do the producers, consumers, and decomposers you identified interact to create a **food web**. (Remember, a **food web** is several **food chains** interacting in a biome...don't forget about **competition**)
8. What sources did you use to find your information?
9. What sources did you use to find your pictures?
